TRAVEL ADVISORY NO.14 OF 2ND JUNE 2023

On the 22nd March 2023, the government of the United Republic of Tanzania (URT) issued a Travel Advisory Number 13 following the declaration of Marburg Viral Disease (MVD) outbreak in Kagera Region, Tanzania. In collaboration with various stakeholders, Tanzania has jointly and successfully responded to the Marburg Viral Disease (MVD) that led to an official **DECLARATION OF END OF MVD** outbreak on 02nd June 2023 in Kagera Region.

Therefore the URT is updating its Travel Advisory effective from 02nd June 2023, as follows;

1. At any point of entry (airport, ground crossing or port) will resume routine travel procedures by the Port Health Authority as per International Health Regulation (IHR).
2. Surveillance for 21- days of travelers entering and exiting Kagera is no longer required.
3. Everyone including all Conveyances operators should observe routine Infection Preventing and Control (IPC) measures such as Hand Hygiene at all time regardless of the end of MVD.
4. Routine decontamination of Vehicles entering in and or departing Kagera is no longer required.

NB: The Travel Advisory will be reviewed from time to time as the need arises.
